NEWS UPDATE The appointment of a Chief Officer

The Board is pleased to confirm the appointment of its new Chief Officer. After interviews this week, we are delighted to advise that Jocelyn Pike has been appointed to the role.

Jocelyn will be seconded to the Southern Norfolk Clinical Commissioning Group from NHS Norfolk to provide strategic leadership to the emerging CCG.

Her formal appointment is from 26th September 2011 and will in her first few weeks work with the Board on the proposed structure for the CCG, both in terms of operational needs and clinical engagement. Jocelyn will also work closely on moving the CCG towards authorisation. We know she has every intention of meeting the wider South Norfolk team in the early days of her appointment.

Many people will know Jocelyn from her current role at NHS Norfolk as the Assistant Director Planned Care (Central Delivery Unit) working with Ian Ayres and his team on transformation. Prior to that she has over 10 years experience in strategic roles within the health care arena.

She joins the CCG with a wealth of experience in commissioning, which will be invaluable as we continue to work on our commissioning intentions for 2012/2013.

Jocelyn will be representing Southern Norfolk CCG at the regular Chief Officer Network meetings for Norfolk, working closely with the Chief Officer's of the other Norfolk CCGs.
